ELIGIBILITY

- U.S. citizen
- Undergraduate or graduate students on track to commission through the Army, Naval, or Air Force Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC),

contracted or non-contracted, at a regionally accredited college or university in the United States. Marine Platoon Leaders Class (PLC) students are also eligible.

• No prior Arabic experience is required. Students of all language levels are invited to participate in the program. Based on a placement test, you will enroll in the level appropriate for your Arabic language proficiency.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

 Scholarship: All ROTC cadets and midshipmen accepted into the program are guaranteed full scholarship funding which covers tuition, airfare, room and board, health insurance, local transportation, books, and transcripts. Students typically spend \$500 per month in personal expenses which are not covered by the program.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: January 17, 2025

All applications will be reviewed after the deadline.
